**AMYAC COMMUNITY AND NATIVE TITLE AUTHORISATION MEETING –
DIRECT BENEFITS TRUST**

Dear AMYAC member and AMY native title holder,

This letter is to provide notice for a community and an authorisation meeting for Antakirinja Matu-Yankunytjatjara (**AMY**) members and native title holders.

The meeting details are as follows:

Date:	15 September 2026: Native title authorisation meeting (Day 1) 16 September 2026: Community meeting (Day 2)

Why is there a meeting?

At the native title meeting on 19 November 2025, the Antakirinja Matu-Yankunytjatjara native title holders authorised AMYAC to enter into an indigenous land use agreement (**ILUA**) to resolve the AMYAC native title compensation claim against the State of South Australia.

As part of the ILUA, the state will pay the compensation settlement in a trust nominated by AMYAC. Based on native title holder feedback to date, AMYAC proposes to establish a direct benefits trust to hold and distribute the compensation amounts. It will be the native title holders' decision to establish the trust and nominate it to receive the compensation settlement. These decisions will be made on Day 1. Further information about these decisions can be found in the native title notice at **page 3**.

Perpetual as the proposed initial trustee will speak with native title holders on Day 2 about the distribution policy under the proposed direct benefits trust. Perpetual will present on what native title holders have said so far about distributions of direct benefits, and what some options might be for distribution policy principles, for further native title holder feedback. **No formal decisions are proposed** for the distribution policy at this meeting.

Native title holders' assistance

Applications for assistance to attend the community meeting will need to be received by the AM-Y Indigenous Community Trust (**the Trust**) office **before 4th September 2026**.

The Trust will provide mileage and accommodation assistance to members in accordance with the Trust policy at **page 5**.

For members that have applied through the Trust, a gift card (no tobacco, no alcohol) of \$200.00 to purchase food during the authorisation meeting will be available for collection from the AMYAC office the day before the meeting or on sign in. Members should present a form of ID when collecting their card.

The Trust would like to remind native title holders that they will need to book and pay for their own accommodation. Members that attend the meeting can seek reimbursement for accommodation upon checkout by providing a receipt to the Trust office. This will be reimbursed within 3-4 business days. The name and bank details on the receipt will need to match the details of the member who applied for assistance.

AMY NATIVE TITLE HOLDERS' MEETING 15 SEPTEMBER 2026

A meeting of Antakirinja Matu-Yankunytjatjara (**AMY**) native title holders will be held at **9:30am** on Tuesday **15 September 2026** at the **AMYAC office**.

This meeting is for those persons who are native title holders for the Antakirinja Matu-Yankunytjatjara Native Title Determination Area. This includes members of the Antakirinja Matu-Yankunytjatjara Aboriginal Corporation RNTBC (**AMYAC**) and other native title holders with native title rights and interests in this land. AMYAC members and AMY native title holders are welcome and encouraged to attend the meeting.

Why is there a meeting?

At the native title meeting on 19 November 2025, the Antakirinja Matu-Yankunytjatjara native title holders authorised AMYAC to enter into an indigenous land use agreement (**ILUA**) to resolve the AMYAC native title compensation claim against the State of South Australia.

As part of the ILUA, the state will pay the compensation settlement in a trust nominated by AMYAC. Based on native title holder feedback to date, AMYAC proposes to establish a direct benefits trust to hold and distribute the compensation amounts. It will be the native title holders' decision to establish the trust and nominate it to receive the compensation settlement.

This meeting has been called to consult with AMY native title holders, and to seek native title consent on the establishment of a direct benefits trust to receive and manage moneys received under the ILUA.

What are the decisions?

At the meeting, native title holders will be consulted with and asked to make consent decisions on:

1. the establishment of the AMY Direct Benefits trust;
2. the nomination of the AMY Direct Benefits Trust to receive the native title compensation settlement sum pursuant to clauses 15.1 and 16.1(c) of the ILUA; and
3. the appointment of Perpetual Trustee Company Limited as the initial trustee for the AMY Direct Benefits Trust.

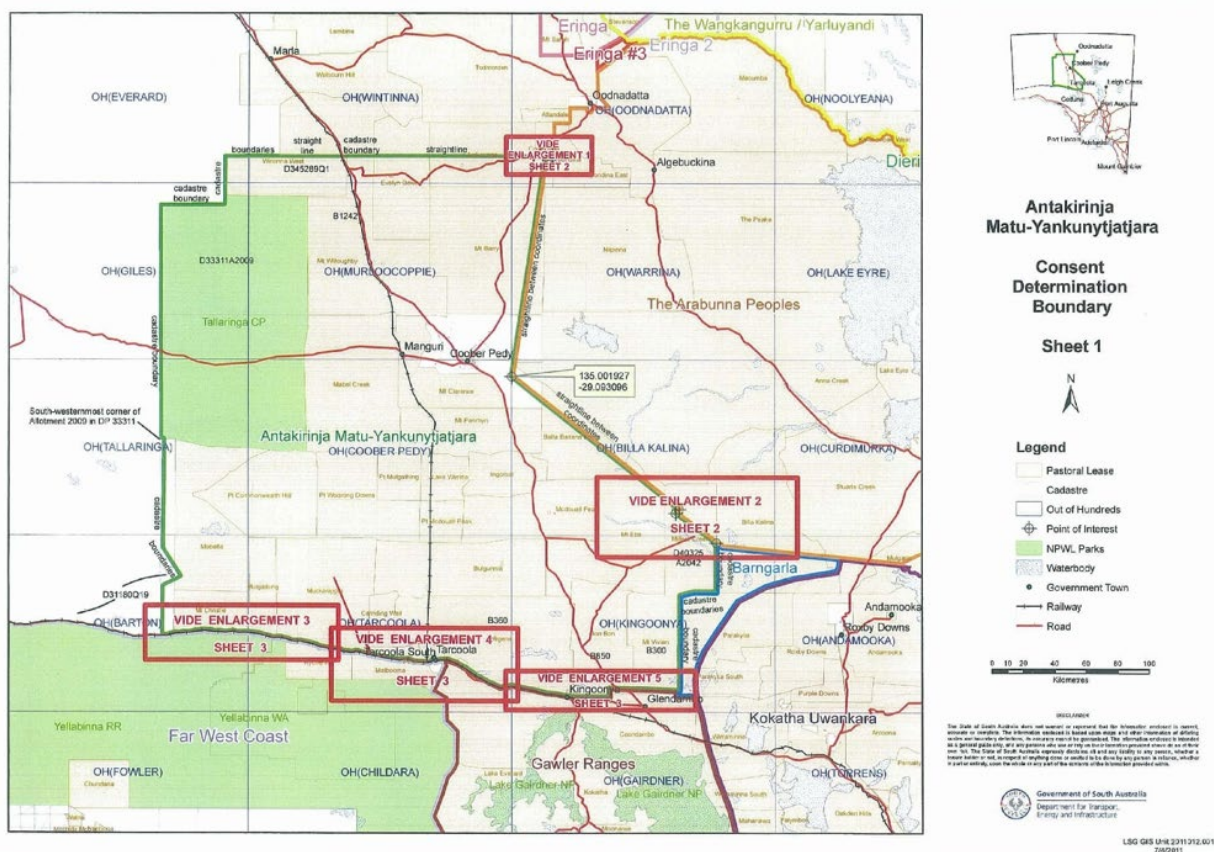
Who are the native title holders?

According to the AMY Consent Determination (SAD6007/1998), the AMY native title holders are:

Those Aboriginal people who, under the relevant traditional laws and customs of the Western Desert Bloc, have a spiritual connection to the native title determination area (Determination Area) and the <i>Tjukurpa</i> associated with it because:	
1.	The Determination Area is their country of birth (also reckoned by the area where their mother lived during the pregnancy); OR
	He or she has had a long term association with the Determination Area such that he or she has traditional geographical and religious knowledge of that country; OR
	he or she has an affiliation to the Determination Area through a parent or grandparent with a connection to the area as specified in (a) or (b) above; AND
2.	They are recognised under the relevant Western Desert traditional laws and customs by other members of the native title holding group as having rights and interests in the Determination Area.

Accommodation - AM-YAC members are to book and pay for their own accommodation. AM-YAC members that attend the meeting can arrange reimbursement for a maximum of **three nights'** accommodation by providing a receipt to the Executive Office upon checkout. Please note:

AM-YAC AGM Assistance Policy

This policy supports AM-YAC Members to attend the **Authorisation Meeting** on 15-16 September 2026.



What is it?

- AM-YAC members who confirm their attendance for the meeting can receive assistance with travel.
- Applications must be completed and submitted to the Executive Office before the closing date. Late applications or last-minute changes may not be accepted.
- AM-YAC members must book their own accommodation, and the trust will reimburse up to \$200 per night with invoices provided.
- Members confirming attendance but failing to sign in without a valid reason will incur a debt and be placed on the Poor Conduct Register. This debt will also be recovered from future AGM Assistance applications.

Important Note: All Members who are attending the Authorisation Meeting must confirm attendance before the meeting to receive their food voucher.

What can funds be used for?
